What is the grossest thing you've ever eaten?

Choose questions for your small group.

1. What was your favorite part about the message today? What's one thing you learned?
2. In your opinion, what are some reasons superhero movies are so appealing to people? (*It's a reflection of all of our stories—God saves all of us, etc.*)
3. Read the **point** (*printed on the front*). What kind of cure are we called to carry? (*The Good News that Jesus cures our sins when we choose to follow Him.*)
4. How would you describe what Jesus did for us to someone who has no idea who Jesus is?
5. Does sharing about Jesus make you nervous? What makes you feel that way?
6. Read **Mark 16:15 ESV** (*printed on the front of this guide*). What do you think is important about sharing your faith with other people?
7. Take prayer requests and pray for your students.

Leader Notes/Announcements

*Promote **Swerve** to your 6th grade students.

*Encourage your students to **invite their friends** to Loop. We're learning that the Gospel is worth sharing, and bringing people to Loop is a great way to start sharing your faith.
