6. Read **1 Timothy 4:12 NLT**. What are some ways you can be an example or be more mature?
7. Is it easy or hard for you to believe that you can set an example for all believers? What makes you say that?
8. Talk about a time you set a good example for someone else. What did you do?
9. Take prayer requests and spend time praying together.
