Icebreaker: What was your favorite childhood book?

- What one thing stuck out to you most?

- Read **Revelation 12:11**. What does Scripture say about the power of our stories?
- Share about a time when you've experienced life change.
- Pastor Craig has said, "Grace saves; truth frees." What does this mean to you? Is there a part of your story you need to view with a lens of grace? What about a lens of truth?
- If you haven't yet, take time to share your story of coming to know Christ. How do you think God can use your story to impact others?
