Emcee Leads

Small Group Leaders Lead

Small Group Icebreaker (5 min.)

- **Introduce** yourself. **Welcome** students by name. **Check in** with them to see how they're doing.
- Icebreaker: **If you had to live inside the world of a video game, which one would you choose?**

Welcome (30 sec.)

- **Welcome** everyone and **say** our three simple Loop rules: **Respect your leaders. Respect each other. Respect the room.**
- **Invite** everyone to stand and **join in** worship.

Transition to Episode (30 sec.)

- Get students excited for this week's episode of The Loop Show!

Today's Loop Show talks about learning God's wisdom by following wise examples. What challenges will we get to watch Ricky & Jayme tackle as we learn about that? Let's find out together right now!

Offering and Announcements (2 min.)

- **Recap** teaching in one sentence.
- **Celebrate** hands raised during the salvation video.
- **Show** the spot where students can give their tithes and offerings.
- **Pray** for tithes and offerings.
- **Say**: Did you know there are super fun **YouVersion Bible Plans** just for Loop students? There are! You'll learn more about God, watch a Loop Show video, and read some Bible verses each day. Ask your small group leader for more information.
- **Transition** to Activity.

Activity (10 min.)

Game Objective

Design your own wise character for a video game of your creation.

You'll Need

Wise Hero activity sheet (1 per student)
Set of markers (1 per group)

Set Up

No additional set up required

How to Play

Say: We got to watch Ricky and Jayme in their own video game today. Now it's your turn! You get to design your very own video game character—8-bit style!

Give each student a Wise Hero activity sheet.

1. Students **fill in** their answers on the sheet and **create** their own wise character for their own video game!
2. Students **share** what they designed if they'd like, as time allows.

Small Group Discussion (10 min.)

Review Today's Big Question

If you created a character that was wise, what qualities would they have?

Review Today's Bible Verse

James 1:5 NLT

If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking.

- What does this Bible verse mean to you?

More Questions to Keep Your Group Talking

- What stood out to you the most from today's Loop Show? What's one thing you learned?
- When you have a difficult decision to make, how do you usually choose what to do?
- Name someone who would help you live your life God's way if you were to follow in their footsteps.
- If someone came to you looking for help in making a difficult choice—or because they didn't know what to do in a situation—how would you help them?
- This week, reach out to someone you view as a godly, wise person. Ask them if they will be your mentor, or if it would be okay if you reached out to them for godly advice every now and then.

Pray Together

Spend some time checking in with the students in your group. How are they doing? Anything they want to ask God for? Anything they want to thank God for? Pray together.
