
# NextGen Leaders of Today









#### Getting to Know Each Other

#### We're Not Just a Building

We want to help kids and students find a place to belong, and we want that for you, too. Why? Because we believe life change happens through trusted relationships.

#### **How Do I Get to Know People?**

We get it. Finding trusted relationships is a process, and it's not always easy. We're here to help as you find your people, because we want everyone who serves in NextGen to feel like they're a part of a family.

#### **Getting to Know NextGen**

So, what exactly is NextGen? NextGen is the area of our church that focuses on leading kids and students from the day they're born through their high school years by partnering with and supporting their families along the way.

#### Bring in.

Bring people into the Church and introduce them to Jesus.

#### Build up.

Build people up by helping them discover who they are in Christ and the freedom He offers.

#### Train.

Train people to love God with all their heart, soul, mind, and strength and to love others the same way Jesus loves them.

#### Send out.

Send people out to lead others to become fully devoted followers of Christ.

## We do all of this so that kids and students will ...

- Know who God is.
- Understand who they are because of Jesus.
- Choose to live in biblical community.
- Start using their gifts for the good of others.

All of this happens in three primary lanes: **LifeKids, Switch, and Parents.** 



**LifeKids**: We provide experiences for kids from birth through 6th grade every weekend, at every service.

### **Switch**

**Switch**: 6-12th grade students meet for worship and small groups on Wednesday nights, and they can serve during our weekend services.

### 25 Parents

**Parents**: Parents are the most influential voices in the lives of the children and students we serve. That's why we partner with them by providing resources and connecting them to relationships so they can lead their families with confidence.

Salvation is God's free gift to us, but we must accept it.


People will exist eternally with or without God.

#### Living and Modeling Our Beliefs

The Apostle Paul wrote these words to Timothy, a young church leader, about what faithfully leading and teaching in the church involves:

... Be an example to all believers in what you say, in the way you live, in your love, your faith, and your purity. ... Keep a close watch on how you live and on your teaching. Stay true to what is right for the sake of your own salvation and the salvation of those who hear you. 1 Timothy 4:12, 16 NLT

This doesn't mean we never sin or we have all the answers. It means we are committed to letting the teachings of Scripture shape the words we say and the way we live.

If you're new to following Jesus, some of the ways He asks us to follow Him can feel pretty different. In fact, compared to what is culturally normal, it can almost feel upside-down. We get that! But we do believe God's way is the best way for us, even when it seems strange.

Serving in NextGen will bring you into a wide variety of conversations with kids, students, and parents that cover lots of different topics. We want you to be able to navigate those conversations with confidence and truth.

Of course, we can't write out every topic we teach in NextGen or all the things we believe as a church. Teaching spans from God's creation of the world to celebrating His nature as a good Father. We don't want to put you in a position of teaching something you don't agree with, so let's dig in to a few things we believe.
