



CREATION GAME ACTIVITY SUPPLEMENT

GOD GIVES TO ME • WEEK 1 • CREATION

Tips:

- The first time you play, go through the days in order.
- The second time you play, read days in any order you like.
- If you can't guess what kids are pretending to be, that's okay. Just ask them.

Game adaptations if a kid in your group has a disability:

- They can say one of the days of creation for the group. (Whisper the words to them so they can share with the group.)
- They can hold up the number on their fingers for each day while you say the words.
- They can participate in the days of creation they're able to act out.

1	On day one, God made day and night. <i>Ideas for kids: Pretend to sleep, wake up, shine like a light, pretend to be in the dark, etc.</i>
2	On day two, God made the sky. <i>Ideas for kids: Pretend to be clouds, rain, snowflakes, wind, thunder, a storm, pretend to fly, etc.</i>
3	On day three, God made land, seas, and plants like trees. <i>Ideas for kids: Pretend to be a wave in the ocean, a tree, a flower, a cactus, an island, a bush, etc.</i>
4	On day four, God made the sun, moon, and stars. <i>Ideas for kids: Pretend to be the sun, moon, or stars</i>
5	On day five, God made fish to swim and birds to fly. <i>Ideas for kids: Pretend to swim or fly, pretend to be a fish, shark, octopus, dolphin, bird, whale, etc.</i>
6	On day six, God made animals to live on the land—and people! <i>Ideas for kids: Pretend to be a lion, horse, wolf, rabbit, cat, dog, mouse, sheep, human, etc.</i>
7	On day seven, God made NOTHING! He rested. <i>Ideas for kids: Pretend to sleep, read, do nothing, relax in the pool, eat a snack, stretch, draw, etc.</i>
