Countdown Timer

Start video when experience begins • Tidy room · Get into a small group with your kids



Small Group Welcome

Get kids talking • Help each kid in your small group feel seen and heard

- **Introduce** yourself and **welcome** kids by name.
- Catch up on prayer requests and life events.
- Talk about welcome question: What do you want to be good at when you're a grown-up?

After Activity

To Do

Say: When we trust and follow Jesus, we're a part of His Church! Each of us has an important job to do, and if we don't do it, a piece of the puzzle is missing. Like this:

- 1. Show the Puzzle activity supplement for a visual aid. and **point** to the puzzle piece that's out of place on it.
- 2. Give each kid a blank puzzle piece and place markers where all kids can access them.

Say: This puzzle piece is you! Draw or write the special things you're good at on your puzzle piece. Those are things you can do to serve others and do your job in the Body of Christ.

- 3. Kids draw or write unique ways they can serve the Body of Christ on their puzzle piece. Offer ideas from "Things God Made Me Good At" supplement printed on back of this guide.
- 4. Connect puzzle pieces from your group to show how well each of you fit together in the Body of Christ.
- 5. Disassemble puzzle pieces when time's up, and give kids their puzzle piece to take home.

Small Group Talk & Prayer

Get kids talking • Pray with your small group Build relationships

Review the Point and Bible verse:

Be true to who God made you to be.

Ephesians 4:24 NIV ... put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

What do you like about this Bible verse?

Choose a question to get your group talking:

- What do you think kids mean when they say, "Be true to yourself?"
- How is it different when you're true to just yourself instead of being true to who you are in Jesus?
- When you choose to follow Jesus, you are still you-but you put on a "new self." What do you think Jesus would say about the person He made you to be?
- How would you help a friend who thought they were good at something, but it turned out they weren't?

Pray Together:

- **Ask** kids what they'd like to talk with God about.
- **Lead** prayer or help kids **pray** for each other.

What to do with extra time:

- **Help** kids **talk** with each other and **build** friendships.
- **Do** the small group activity again or **play** a game like Simon Says or 20 questions.



Check Out

Greet parents • Praise kids • Stay in small group until check out ends
