Small Group Leaders Lead

Small Group Icebreaker (5 min.)

- Introduce yourself. Welcome students by name.
 Check in with them to see how they're doing.
- Icebreaker: What's one fun thing you'd like to accomplish this year?

Welcome (30 sec.)

- Welcome everyone and say our three simple Loop rules: Respect your leaders. Respect each other. Respect the room.
- Invite everyone to stand for worship.

Transition to Episode (30 sec.)

 Get students excited for this week's episode of The Loop Show!

Today, we get to answer a question from YOU on The Loop Show. That's right! The Loop Show is responding to a postcard sent in by a fellow Loop student! Could it be yours? Let's watch right now!

Offering and Announcements (2min.)

- Recap teaching in one sentence.
- Celebrate hands raised during the salvation video.
- Show the spot where students can give their tithes and offerings.
- Pray for tithes and offerings.
- Say: 6th graders, if you're having fun in Loop, ask your small group leader what it means to be a Student Leader!
- Transition to Activity.

Activity (10 min.)

Game Objective

Unscramble the words on the activity sheet.

You'll Need

Word Unravel activity sheet (1 per student)
Pen or pencil (1 per student)

Set Up

No additional prep needed

How to Play

Say: Today, we watched Ricky and Jayme wear 15 sweaters! Now, you get a chance to unscramble—or *unravel*—words and phrases from today's Loop Show!

- Give each student a Word Unravel activity sheet and something to write with.
- Students unscramble the words on the sweaters, writing the answers in the blanks provided below each sweater.
- Help students who are stuck, showing them the answer key printed upside down on the bottom of their page.
- 4. With any remaining time, **students draw** patterns and designs on the sweaters.
- 5. Use this time to **chat** and **refresh** students' memories over the concepts they learned and the fun things they saw on *The Loop Show* today. Have fun and get to know your students!

More Questions to Keep Your Group Talking

- What's one thing you want to talk about from today's Loop Show?
- What would you tell someone who was worried about what happens when they die?
- What's something you wish you could know about eternity or eternal life?
- How does it make you feel to know that everyone who trusts and follows Jesus has access to eternal life with God right now?
- Is there anyone you can think of who might like to come with you to Loop? How could you invite them to come with you next week?

Pray Together

Check in with the students in your group. How are they doing? Anything they want to ask God for? Anything they want to thank God for? Pray together.
