

TRADE OR NO TRADE? ACTIVITY SUPPLEMENT WEEK 3 • JESUS DIES ON THE CROSS

Game adaptation if a kid in your group has a disability:

- Say one trade from the list.
- Kids who would trade give a thumbs up or say, "Trade!"
- Kids who wouldn't trade give a thumbs down or say, "No trade!"

Tips:

- If kids aren't sure what it means to trade, try explaining it this way: When you give your friend something, they give you something else, so you both still have something.
- Give an example: A trade is like this: If you have a lollipop, and your friend has a balloon, you give your lollipop to your friend, and your friend gives you their balloon.

Trades:

- You have chocolate cake. Your friend has strawberry cake. Trade, or no trade?
- You have a red jacket. Your friend has a blue jacket. Trade, or no trade?

- You have a space snake. Your friend has a glowing sloth. Trade, or no trade?
- You have an airplane. Your friend has a speed boat. Trade, or no trade?
- You have broccoli. Your friend has carrots. Trade, or no trade?
- You have a silly movie. Your friend has a superhero movie. Trade, or no trade?
- You have a coloring book. Your friend has a story book. Trade, or no trade?
