Small Group Welcome

3 min

Get kids talking • Help each kid in your small group feel seen and heard

- **Introduce** yourself and **welcome** kids by name.
- **Catch up** on prayer requests and life events.
- **Talk about** welcome question: **What's the biggest mess you've ever had to clean up?**

Small Group Activity

Have fun doing activity with your small group

You'll Need

Per Kid	1 Cardboard circle
Per Group	10 Sheets of paper 1 Set of markers

After Activity

Kids Keep	Their cardboard shield
You Keep	Paper wads and markers (save to reuse)

To Do

Say: Let's pretend these are your shields to help you join Jesus in fighting evil! What good things did He make you good at to help this world be good and new? Draw a few things you're really good at on your shield!

1. **Give** each kid a cardboard circle and a **place** markers where kids can access them.
2. Kids **write** or **draw** their ideas on their shields. As kids work, **read** ideas from the All Things New activity supplement printed on back to help.
3. **Crumple** the sheets of paper into wads (if not already done).

Say: Okay, let's test those shields! Stop coloring, and hold them up to see how you can fight alongside Jesus!

4. **Read** an idea from the activity supplement, then **toss** paper wads at the shields.
5. **As time allows, repeat** step 4, **reading** a new situation for each round

Review the Point: You can help Jesus make all things new. Ask Him what He made you to do.

Review the Verse: **Locate Bibles** in the room, **look up** the verse together, and **talk about** what's the same and what's different if it's in a different translation.

Revelation 19:16 NLT *On his robe at his thigh was written this title: King of all kings and Lord of all lords.*

- Close your eyes and listen to this Bible verse. What does it make you think about?
- Choose a Question to Get Your Group Talking**
- What are some unfair or wrong things that upset you?
 - What are some good things you can do to help Jesus make all things new?
 - When something isn't fair or right, what gives you hope inside your heart?

Wrap Up

- **Pray** together.
- **Do** the small group activity again or **play** a game like *Charades* or *Duck, Duck, Goose*.

Leader Tip

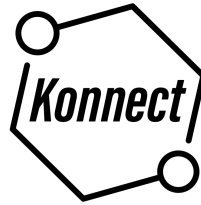
Be consistent in how you treat kids in your group. If you over-reward one kid or over-reprimand another, they might think you have favorites. This can erode their trust.

Ways to make all things new:

Use these ideas for both drawing/writing on the shields and playing the game.

- When people leave trash on the ground, I can pick it up.
- When someone is sad, I can draw a beautiful picture to make them smile.
- When someone feels left out, I can show kindness to them.
- When someone feels like no one cares about them, I can give them a gift.
- When someone is sick, I can pray for them.
- When a pet needs food, water, or love, I can take care of them.
- When a little kid throws a fit, I can be gentle with them.
- When my friends want to do something wrong, I can stand up for what's right.
- When I want to argue, instead I can choose to listen and talk respectfully.
- When someone doesn't know Jesus loves them, I can tell them how to be His friend.
- When people are hungry, I can share some food with them.
- If I disagree with someone, I can still choose to be kind and loving to them.
- When someone is sad, I can say an encouraging Bible verse to them.
- When I want to complain about schoolwork, I can write a thank-you note to my teacher instead.
- When a bully is picking on me or someone else, I can tell them to stop, and tell a trusted adult.
- If someone seems upset, I can ask them if they'd like to talk about it.
- When someone feels lonely, I can spend time with them.
- If I see something scary, confusing, or weird, I can tell a trusted adult.
- When I see a huge mess, I can help clean it up.
- When someone seems worried or stressed out, I can ask what I can do to help.
- When someone gets hurt, I can tell a trusted adult. I can even get them a Band-Aid!
- When people are fighting, I can try to help them work it out and get help from a trusted adult.
- When something seems unfair, I can speak up with respectful words.
- When someone is crying a lot, I can sit with them quietly.
- When someone needs to relax, I can help them take deep breaths and be still.
