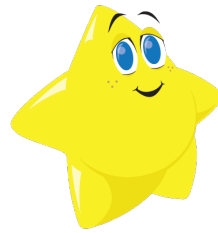


# Small Group Leader Guide



## Week 2

God's Amazing  
Promise

### Question

How do I show faith?

### Answer

I can trust God!

### Bible Verse

Psalm 31:14 NIV  
... I trust in you, LORD; I say,  
"You are my God."

### What To Do First

#### Review

1. **Introduce** yourself.
2. **Say** the **Question**, **Answer**, and **Verse** together.

#### Read

1. **Lay** Story Cards in order.
2. **Point** to the first card.
3. **Read** the caption.
4. **Ask** the **Question**. *Kids answer.*
5. **Do Action** together.
6. **Repeat** steps 2-5 for Story Cards 2-5.

#### Remember

##### Mix It Up

1. **Shuffle** Story Cards.
2. **Place** Story Cards in the wrong order.
3. **Say**, "This story's mixed up! Let's fix it."
4. Group **helps** put Story Cards in order.

### Review Questions & Actions

#### Story Card 1

#### Question

Who did Abraham trust?  
*God*

#### Action

Pretend to listen to God with Abraham. Put your hand behind your ear.

#### Story Card 2

#### Question

Did God keep His promise? *Yes! God gave Abraham and Sarah a son.*

#### Action

Many years later, Abraham and Sarah had a son! Hold the baby!

#### Story Card 3

#### Question

Who told Abraham where to go? *God*

#### Action

Pretend to pack up and move with Abraham.

#### Story Card 4

#### Question

What did God promise to give to Abraham's children? *The land*

#### Action

Pretend to build with Abraham.

#### Story Card 5

#### Question

How did Abraham feel about trusting God? *Glad*

#### Action

Praise God with Abraham!

### How To Wrap Up

#### Talk

God promised Abraham would have a big family. How big is your family?

#### Pray

Ask kids what they want to talk to God about, and pray with them.

### Check Out Time

#### Begin When Parents Arrive

1. **Combine** your Small Groups if you need to free up a leader.
2. One leader **stands** at the door to **greet** parents and **run** check out.
3. When a kid leaves, **tell** the parents something positive about their kid.
4. **Encourage** parents to take a picture of the Parent Convo card.
5. **Keep kids busy in small groups:** Do Story Card activities, let kids share what's on their mind, or pray together to build closer relationships.
