- **Talk about** welcome question: **Which flavor of pudding is your favorite?**

You'll Need

Per Kid & Leader	1 Jumping frog 1 Blindfold
Per Group	Nothing

After Activity

Kids Keep	Their blindfold and frog*
You Keep	*Keep frogs until it's time for kids to go

To Do

Say: Jesus said, "If a blind person leads another who is blind, both of them will fall into a pit." What do you think it would be like for someone to close their eyes and lead someone else who also has their eyes closed?

1. Kids **respond**. Next, **give** everyone a jumping frog and a blindfold. **Show** kids how to make their frog "jump" by placing it on the ground and pressing down on the tail.
2. **Place** lily pad target (printed on back) in center of group and **get ready to put on** your blindfold.

Say: Well, I won't be able to see much, but I'll try to tell you how to get your frog on the lily pad!

3. All of you **put on** blindfolds and try to jump frog onto the lily pad for a while. **Say** silly things like, "Try aiming left? Or maybe right? Maybe you're already on the lily pad?"

Note: Be sure to peek out of your blindfold the entire time to make sure group is having fun safely.

Say: That was silly! I couldn't give good advice! Let's have fun getting our frogs on the lily pad with our blindfolds off.

4. Kids **remove** blindfolds and try again. **Continue** playing with or without blindfolds as time allows.
5. **Collect** frogs when time's up and **return them to kids** to take home when they're leaving.

Review the Point: Think. Pray. Then follow.

Review the Verse: *Find Bibles in room. Look up verse together. **Talk about what's different and/or the same if in-room Bible is a different translation.***

- What do you think makes Jesus the best example to follow?
 - What clues can you look for to see if someone's example is good to follow?

 - If someone followed your example, what do you think they would learn about Jesus?

Wrap Up

- **Pray** together.
- **Play** a game like *Rock, Paper, Scissors* or *I Spy*

Leader Tip

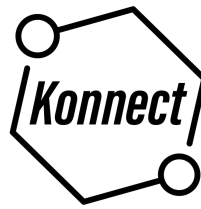
Extend discussion with follow-ups like, "Tell me more about that." Or, "How did you come to learn that?"
